Maryland Wins ACC Track Meet

RALEIGH, N.C. (AP) — Defending champion Maryland won the Atlantic Coast Conference track championship with plenty to spare Saturday as five records were broken and one was tied.

Maryland, winner of 11 of the last 12 ACC track titles, piled up 95 points to 38 for runner-up Clemson. North Carolina received 35 points, South Carolina 32, Duke 20, North Carolina State 7, Wake Forest 10 and Virginia 8.

The Terps were led by Mike Cole, who was voted the outstanding performer by the coaches. Cole won the broad jump and 220-yard dash, finished third in the 100-yard dash and was on the winning 440-yard relay team.

Records were broken in the mile run, 440-yard run, high jump, mile relay and javelin and tied in the 330-yard relay. Three records fell in Friday's qualifying trials, discus, javelin and shot put.

Maryland sophomore Frank Costello cleared the high jump at 6 feet 10 inches to better the old ACC record of 6 feet, 6¾ inches set last year by Tommy Clark of North Carolina.

"I never felt better jumping than I did today," said Costello. He failed in three attempts to clear the bar at seven feet.

Maryland's Russell White, who broke the javelin record Friday, did it again Saturday with a throw of 239 feet, 5½ inches. His record toss Friday was 224 feet, 1 inch.

Another Maryland performer, Steve Lamb, ran the 440 in 47.6 to top the conference record of 47.7 set in 1963 by Chris Stauffer of Maryland.
