CHAPEL HILL, N. C., March 1 (P)—Burr Grim, Maryland's great miler, set two conference records tonight to set the pace as the Terps piled up 53 2-5 points to retain their team title in the fifth annual Atlantic Coast Conference Indoor Games.

North Carolina came in second in the conference division with 29 1-5 points, Duke had 18½, South Carolina 18 1-3, Clemson 9, Virginia 7 13-15, North Carolina State 5 1-5, and Wake Forest 1½.

Maryland also walked away with the freshman division, piling up 51 points to 18 for runner-up Virginia. N. C. State got 13, Duke 6, North Carolina 5, Clemson 3 and Wake Forest 3.

In the non-conference division, VMI led with 25 points. Florida State was second with 17. Georgia Tech received 10, Furman 8, The Citadel 7, Richmond 7, Davidson 2 and Georgia 1.

Maryland won seven events in the conference division. Nine records were set, five in the varsity conference division and four in the freshman division. One con-
