

CHAPEL HILL (AP) — Six conference marks were set Saturday as Maryland won the 18th annual Atlantic Coast Conference Indoor Track meet.

The Terrapins, who have won the meet 17 times in its 18-year history, totaled 49½ points to runner up Duke's 34. Hosting North Carolina finish third with 32 points, while South Carolina got 30.

Clemson was fifth with 17½ points, and North Carolina State and Virginia tied for sixth with 12. Wake Forest had five points.
