

Des Moines, May 10.—Nine conference records were broken and one tied in the annual Iowa collegiate conference track meet here today. Des Moines university won first place with 78 points, and Simpson college was second with 28 points. Other schools finished as follows: Iowa Teachers, 18½; Penn, 16; Morningside, 12; Iowa Wesleyan, 9; Buena Vista, 8½; Parsons, 8; St. Ambrose, 4; West Union, 3.

St. Ambrose made second place in the half mile relay and fourth place in the 100 yards dash, by Harden. Three of the four points made by the Saints were scored in the relay.

New conference records established at the meet were in the 120-yard high hurdles, mile run, shot put, 440-yard run. Second heat, discuss, two mile run, high jump, 220-yard dash, and broad jump. The previous record in the first heat of the 440-yard dash was tied by Montgomery of Des Moines.

St. Ambrose athletes competing in the meet were Harden, Hippler, McCool, Lawler, O'Hare, Marchella, Murphy, G. O'Donnell, J. O'Donnell, Campana, West and Quasney.

220-yard low hurdles — Banch (Buena Vista) first; Miller (Teach-

ers) second; Prugs (Simpson) third; Anderson (Penn) fourth. Time: 26.6.

Discus throw—Girard (Simpson) first; Koch (Western Union) second; Whitesides (Des Moines) third; Munson (Morningside) fourth. Distance, 124 feet 9 inches. (New record).

One mile relay—(Des Moines) Foy, Gabriel, Corzatt, Montgomery, first; Parsons, second; Teachers, third. Only three teams competed. Time: 3:37.

880-yard run—Wiedeman (Simpson) first; Nisson (Morningside) second; Corzatt (Des Moines) third; Frinden (Penn) fourth. Time: 2:00.1.

Two mile run—Auld (Penn) first; Simpson (Des Moines) second; Oliver (Wesleyan) third; Speer (Des Moines) fourth. Time: 10:19.4. (New record).

High jump—G. Simpson (Des Moines) first; Kingery (Simpson) second; Moore (Des Moines) Bates (Simpson) and Sheppard Simpson tied for third. Height, 5 feet 10½ inches. (New record).

Half mile relay—Simpson, McCoy, Sheppard, Wiedeman, Prugh, first; St. Ambrose, second; Parsons, third; Penn, fourth. No time given. Buena Vista won this race in 1:34 but was disqualified for fouling on the curve.

Javelin throw—Eastburn (Wesleyan) first; Fottal (Teachers) second; Harting (Des Moines) third; Sheppard (Simpson) fourth. Distance, 171 feet, 2½ inches.

220-yard dash — Page (Des Moines) first; Montgomery (Des Moines) second; Smith (Wesleyan) third; Rocho (Des Moines) fourth. Time: 23.1. (New record).

Broad jump—Whiteside (Des Moines) first; Edwards (Des Moines) second; Hartzell (Morningside) third; Hartman (Simpson) fourth. Distance, 21 feet, 10½ inches.
