

### HOW THEY FINISHED.

The Iowa State Teachers college track team, by placing in every event except the low hurdles, amassed a total of 57 1-7 points and carried off first honors in the annual Iowa conference cinder path meet held at the Des Moines university field yesterday afternoon. Simpson took second place with 43 1-7 points and Parsons annexed third with a total of 24 1-7 points. Penn accumulated 15 points and was closely followed by Buena Vista with 13. Morningside with 12 2-7, Des Moines and Iowa Wesleyan with 11 1-7 points each.

Two conference records were broken, Auld of Penn shattering the first mark by running the mile in 4:37:4, lowering the old record by one-ninth seconds. Auld took the lead at the start, set a pretty pace and was never hard pushed, easily winning the event by several yards. The second mark was broken by Bates, Simpson star, when he jumped over the bar at 5 feet 11 1/2 inches in the high jump event.

Individual honors went to Hartzell of Morningside and Auld of Penn who were tied with 10 points each. Hartzell took first place in the century dash and came back later to break the tape in the 220-yard dash. Auld was not content with taking first place in the mile run, but also easily captured the two-mile run. Bates of Simpson, who took the high jump and won second place in the 120-yard hurdles, tied with Bates of the Tutor squad who earned second in the pole vault, third in the shotput and discus throw, and fourth in the javelin hurl.

Both relays were interesting races. Buena Vista with Rollins, DeLong, Treene and Ellerbroek running strong quarters, won the mile race without being strongly pushed. In the half-mile relay Buena Vista was leading during the first two laps, but the Iowa State Teachers and Simpson slowly pulled away and finished ahead of Coach Kelly's men in the order named.

Two sections were run in the 440-yard dash. In the first heat, Mahr of Simpson led the field practically all of the way and looked like a sure winner until Montgomery of Des Moines uncorked a reserve of steam in the last ten yards of the race and slipped by the Methodist runner to win the race by inches. The second heat, while not as closely contested at the finish as the first, was won by Ellerbroek of Buena Vista who ran away from his field with apparently little exertion.

Iowa State Teachers, coached by Mendenhall and Cable, had a well balanced team and deserved to win the meet although they were closely pushed throughout the afternoon by Simpson which was only five points behind when the final event of the meet, the broad jump, was staged. But the Teachers came through with flying colors and won the first three places, while Simpson landed fourth in the event. The Tutors, besides garnering ten points in the broad jump, nearly made a slam in the discus when they won the first three places for ten more points. The summaries
