

CEDAR FALLS, May 23.—(AP)—

Iowa State Teachers college retained its Iowa conference outdoor track and field title today by scoring in twelve events to amass a total of 56 1-6 points. Tutor athletes accounted for three of four new conference records set during the meet.

Iowa Wesleyan finished second with 32 5-6 points, Morningside third with 25, and Simpson fourth with 24. The other teams scored as follows: Buena Vista 11, Penn 10, Luther 9, Central 6, Parsons 5, Western Union 3, and Columbia 1 2-3.

Keith Stapley led the Teacher assault with victories in the high jump and pole vault. In the latter event he shattered the record of 12 feet 1 inch, set by himself and a team mate, Baxter, last year, by leaping 12 feet 11 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches.

Grier of the Teachers set a new mark in the broad jump with a leap of 22 feet 5 $\frac{1}{8}$ inches, 3 $\frac{1}{8}$ inches beyond the old mark set by Gardner of the Teachers in 1926.

Sigurd Sandberg, Iowa Wesleyan's husky all-around star, accounted for a new record in the discus throw by heaving the platter 129 feet, 5 inches, 11 inches better than the record set by Gottlob of Morningside in 1928.
