

INDIANOLA, Ia. (AP)—Simpson college rolled up 38 points to win the annual Iowa conference track and field meet here Saturday under a hot sun that beamed down with almost mid-summer intensity.

Parsons college, showing strength in the place and show positions, finished second behind the host squad with 26 points, three more than Dubuque university picked up for third place.

Upper Iowa, featuring Bob Brownell, a classy little miler, moved into the fourth spot with 21 points. Jake Hoekstra, a strapping quarter-miler and dash man, escorted Central college into a fifth place tie with St. Ambrose, each team counting 15½ points.

The rest of the field finished in this order: Iowa-Wesleyan 12, Luther 10, Buena Vista 9, Penn 9, Western Union 5, and Columbia 3.
