Pole vault—Kutchen (Simpson) and Tomke (Loras) tied for first, Werkheiser (Dubuque) third, Irving (Dubuque), Wallstein (Luther), Snyder (Simpson) tied for fourth. Height, 11 feet.

440-yard dash—first section—Won by Jeffreys (Simpson), Wilder (Dubuque) second, B. Farnam (Simpson) third, Davis (Simpson) fourth. Time, :52.2.

Second section—Won by Heineman (Dubuque), Maas (St. Ambrose) second, B. Farnam (Simpson) third, Davis (Simpson) fourth. Time, :52.2.

220-yard low hurdles—Won by Sharp (Simpson), Van Soest (Central) second, Feutz (Dubuque) third, Martin (Simpson) fourth. Time, :25.9.

Discus throw—Won by Lapka (St. Ambrose), Freeman (Dubuque) second, Sullivan (St. Ambrose) third, Martin (Simpson) fourth. Distance, 136 feet 2 inches. (New record; old record 135 feet 11 inches by Lapka in 1941.)

220-yard dash—Won by Glendenning (St. Ambrose), McDowell (Luther) second, O'Brien (Loras) third, Saunders (Loras) fourth. Time, :23.1.

880-yard run—Won by Wilder (Dubuque), Stevenson (Penn) second, Bounds (Simpson) third, Perkins (Dubuque) fourth. Time, 2:03.

880-yard relay—Won by Simpson (Farnham, Sharp, Jeffreys, Davis), Loras second, Dubuque third, St. Ambrose, fourth. Time, 1:33.

Two-mile run—Won by Baumgartner (Dubuque), Brent (Simpson) second, Riedel (Dubuque) third, Voelz (Luther) fourth. Time, 10:34.9.

Broad jump—Won by Borsheim (Western Union), Sadowski (Loras) second, Farnham (Simpson) third, Saunders (Loras) fourth. Distance, 22 feet 2 inches. (New record; old record 22 feet ¼ inch by Borsheim in 1940.)

Mile relay—Won by Simpson (Davis, Farnham, Jeffreys, Sharp), Dubuque second, Loras third, St. Ambrose fourth. Time, 3:31.5.
