

INDIANOLA (P)—Dubuque's high powered track team smashed its own meet record in the mile relay and compiled 70 points Saturday to continue its long reign as track and field champion of the Iowa Conference.

Central, which had been expected to make a close fight of it because of a strong showing in the conference relays earlier this year, finished well behind in second place with 39 points.

It was the sixth straight title for the Spartans whose mile relay team of Merv Thorne, Ron Holzman, Brian McGregor and Dan Hansen, established one of the two new records set in the meet. Hansen anchored a 3:24.3 performance erasing the 3:25.2 mark set by Dubuque in 1954.

Harold Hiemstra of Central ran the 880-yard run in 1:58, clipping two-tenths of a second off the mark set by Dubuque's Arnie Ziegler two years ago.
