INDIANOLA (AP) — Dubuque's Pete Boyd set a record in the half mile and anchored the record-tying mile relay team to lead the Spartan to victory in the Iowa Conference track and field meet Saturday.

Dubuque scored 57 points with Parsons 2nd with 45 and Defending Champion Luther 3rd with 39½.

Boyd ran the half in 1:56.4 to better his own mark set in 1959, and led Dubuque to a 3:24.3 mile relay clocking which equalled the 1956 record set by Dubuque.

Another record was equalled when Bob Okerstrom of Parsons won the 120 high hurdles in :14.9.

The only double winner was Wartburg Sprinter Eddie Skay, who won the 100 in :09.8 and the 220 in :21.9. His victory in the 220 was his 3rd and put him in the 3-time winner's circle along with Boyd and Simpson Broad Jumper Bob Coy who won that event Friday.

Three other defending champions retained their titles. Jerry Kamp of Parsons won the shot Friday, Russ Spearman of Dubuque won the 220 low hurdles Saturday and Bob Johnston of Dubuque took the 2-mile.
