INDIANOLA — Luther college won its eighth straight Iowa conference track meet here Saturday in scoring 69 points. It is the best win streak in track in the history of the loop.

Wartburg and William Penn were close behind with 58 and 56 points, respectively.

Luther's Ron Caucutt set one of three records when he leaped 6-4½ to take the high jump. Teammate Neil Brogren was Luther's other champion when he sailed the discus 150-9.

Central's Flenard Grisby set a mark in the triple jump when he went 46-4.
