PELLA—For the first time in 16 years, the Iowa Conference has a new outdoor track champion.

Central College, the host school, unseated perennial champion Luther College in the two-day meet that concluded here Saturday afternoon. It was the first IAC track title for Central.

The Flying Dutchmen scored 184 points, and Simpson also slipped ahead of Luther, outscoring the Norse 181-179.

Those three teams dominated things, as Wartburg came in fourth with 71 points. Upper Iowa did not enter a team, leaving only seven schools to contest for the title.

Luther's Chris Cudworth set a record in the 3,000 meter steeplechase in 9:20.2 and the Norse's Dave Kust set a mark in the 400 intermediate hurdles. His time was 54.8.

Wartburg's Jim Thompson ran the 5,000 meters in a record time of 15:08.00.

Record-setting performances by Jerry Fitzsimmons and Don Keller paced Central.

Fitzsimmons set a record in the 1500 meter run of 3:53.7. He also won the 800-meter run and was third in the 5,000 meter run.

He was named the meet's most valuable athlete.

Keller won the 200-meter run, the 100-meter dash and anchored the winning 400-meter relay. His time of 10.7 in the 100-meter dash tied the meet record, while the relay team set a record of :42.7
