

AMES WINS FIELD MEET

Aggies Finish First with Score of Fifty-Two Points.

MISSOURI COMES IN SECOND

University of Nebraska Finishes Sixth and Iowa Seventh—Field is Veritable Sea of Mud.

KANSAS CITY, May 23.—With rain falling intermittently all afternoon and the field a veritable sea of mud the Iowa Agricultural college of Ames today annexed the first annual track and field meet of the Missouri Valley Intercollegiate association. Missouri beat Drake by a close margin for second place, while Washington, Kansas, Nebraska and Iowa universities trailed along in the order named. The final score was:

Ames, 52; Missouri, 22; Drake, 19; Washington, 13; Kansas, 11; Nebraska, 9; Iowa, 7.
