## WINS ANNUAL M. V.

### CONFERENCE MEET

**Nebraska Only Other Team in Running and It Finishes a Poor Second.**

**TIGERS SCORE 62 POINTS**

**Nebraska Gets 39 and Kansas,**

**Washington and Osteopaths**

**Tie for Third.**

**TWO RECORDS ARE BROKEN**

**Marks Set in High Jump and**

**Short Dash; Ervin, Wilkin**

**and Bogar Tie in Vault.**

COLUMBIA, Mo., May 25.—Special: Missouri won the Missouri Valley conference meet here this afternoon by making 62 points. The next team was Nebraska with 39. The others rank in the following order:

Kansas university, Washington university and Missouri School of Osteopathy tied with 10 each; Iowa State, 8 1-3; Drake, 6 1-3; Kansas State, 6; Baker, 5; Fairmount, 3 1-3; Westminster, 2.

Sylvester of Missouri was individual point winner with 11 points, and Scholz of Missouri tied for second with Bohm of the School of Osteopathy with 10.

Missouri took six firsts and tied for a seventh. There were two records broken. Rice of Kansas, and Osborne of Missouri, divided honors in the high jump with the bar at 6 feet  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch, breaking the old record of 5 feet 11 $\frac{3}{4}$  inches. Scholz of Missouri ran the 100-yard dash in the face of a wind in :09 4-5, breaking the old record of :10 flat. Drew, the famous Negro runner of Drake, failed to appear.

#### Stone Runs Good Race.

Welborn of Baker university won the half mile in 1:58 3-5, remarkable time considering the wind. Stone of Ames ran a good race, but lost on the sprint and finished in fourth place.

Foreman of the Kansas Aggies showed a remarkable burst of speed on the last 220 yards of the two-mile race and won it by eight yards. Missouri easily won the mile and half-mile relays.

#### Three Tie in Vault.

Three men, Bogar of Fairmount, Ervin of Drake, and Wilkin of Ames tied in the pole vault with the bar at 11 feet 10 inches. The men were all good vaulters, but none of them could make 12 feet.

Missouri and Nebraska were counting neck and neck until the 220-yard low hurdles in which the Tigers took 10 points. From this point on Missouri led throughout the meet and at no time did any other team appear dangerous.

Licut. Robert Simpson, famous Missouri hurdler, gave an exhibition in the high hurdles and also demonstrated hand grenade throwing.

This is the third valley meet to be held on Rollins field. It is Missouri's seventh victory out of eleven meets that have been held. Missouri's easy victory came as a surprise for it was expected that Nebraska would furnish a closer race.

Half-mile relay—Missouri (Pittam, Osborne, Sylvester, Scholz) first. Time, 2:31 1-5.
