KANSAS AGGIES WIN 12TH E ANNUAL M. V. TRACK MEET

Missouri, Winner of Six Last C Scores Second.

Evenly Balanced Team of Point Win-ners Brought Victory to Aggies,

Who Won 2-Mile Run.

Ames, Ia.. May 31.—The Kansas Agriculturat college won the tweifth annual Missouri Valley conference track meet today, scoring 28½ points, two points more than Missouri university, winner of six of the last seven meets. Grinnell, picked by many as the favorite before the meet, tied with lowa State for third, with 24 points. Nebraska, 13½; Kansas university, 12½; American School of Osteopathy, 10; Simpson, 9½; Drake, 7½; Des Moines, 5, and Southwestern State Normal, 4, were other teams scoring. Washington university, St. Louis, and Baker failed to score. The Aggies' victory came as the result of an evenly

Baker failed to score. The Aggles' victory came as the result of an evenly balanced team, which placed in a big majority of events, unexpectedly taking first and second in the two-mile run. Missouri's defeat was due primarily to failure in the dashes. Sylvester, of Missouri, was the individual point winner, with 11. Only one record was broken, a strong wind off-setting a fast track. Bohm, of the American School of Osteopathy, set a new mark by throwing the discus 128

new mark by throwing the discus 128 feet 6½ inches, beating the old record of 126 feet 104-5 inches, held by Thatcher, of Missouri.
