

BREAK SIX M. V. RECORDS

Watson, Kansas, Clips One-Fifth Second From Two-Mile Mark.

Ames, Ia., May 29.—Missouri university won the Missouri valley conference track and field meet today with 33 points. Iowa State was second, with $29\frac{1}{4}$ points; Kansas Aggies, third, with $25\frac{1}{3}$, and Nebraska university, fourth, with $25\frac{1}{4}$.

Six Missouri valley conference records were broken. In the half mile, Johnson, of Des Moines college, finished in 1:56 2-5, which clipped 3-5 off the old record. Carson, of Nebraska, threw the shot 43 feet, $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches, 11 inches farther than any previous record. Watson, of Kansas, clipped one-fifth second off the old record in the two mile run, finishing in 9:45 4-5. The Missouri half mile relay team set a new mark in 1:29 2-5, bettering the old record by one-fifth. A distance of 130 feet, 5 inches with the discus by Kremer, of Washington university, bettered the old record of 128 feet $\frac{1}{2}$ inch.

Schloz, of Missouri, made a new mark for the 220-yard dash, going the distance in 21 3-5, one-fifth better than the old record.

Other point winners were: Grinnell, $12\frac{1}{4}$; Kansas university, 9 7-12; Oklahoma, $8\frac{1}{3}$; Southwestern, 7; Washington, 5; Des Moines college, 5; Missouri School of Osteopathy, 3; Drake, 1.
