versity won the Missouri valley conference track and field meet today with 33 points. Iowa State was second, with 29¼ points; Kansas Aggies, third, with 25½, and Nebraska university, fourth, with 25¼.

Six Missouri valley conference records were broken. In the half mile, Johnson, of Des Moines college, finished in 1:56 2-5, which clipped 3-5 off the old record. Carson, of Nebraska, threw the shot 43 feet, 5½ inches, 11 inches farther than any previous record. Watson, of Kansas, clipped one-fifth second off the old record in the two mile run, finishing in 9:45 4-5. The Missouri half mile relay team set a new mark in 1:29 2-5, bettering the old record by one-fifth. A distance of 130 feet, 5 inches with the discus by Kremer, of Washington university, bettered the old record of 128 feet ½ inch.
