

LINCOLN, Nebr., May 20 (AP) Nebraska scored 105  $\frac{3}{4}$  points today to win a rain-drenched Big Seven Conference track meet in which two records were established.

Colorado pulled into second place with 84  $\frac{1}{2}$  points and Kansas, the indoor champion, was third with 83  $\frac{3}{4}$ . Kansas State took the fourth spot with 74  $\frac{1}{2}$  points. Missouri's defending champs were fifth with 57  $\frac{3}{4}$  and Oklahoma sixth with 53  $\frac{1}{2}$ . Iowa State was a bad seventh at 5  $\frac{3}{4}$  points.
