Tidwell Equals Records

Norman, Okla., May 16 - Charley Tidwell equalled his own collegiate record for the low hurdles around a turn as ten records fell and one was tied in the red-hot Big 8 Conference meet.

Bill Easton's powerful Kansas team won, as expected, with 125 points,

but Oklahoma State was a strong second with 90 points.

Tidwell, NCAA low hurdle champion, ran an easy 9.8 heat in the 100 (along with Oklahoma's Dee Givens and Oklahoma State's Orlando Hazley), anchored Kansas' 440 relay team to a 41 flat record, won the 100 final in 9.4, then ran his record-tying 22.7 in the lows.

Jim Graham, Oklahoma State senior, vaulted 15'34", beating teammate Aubrey Dooley's 15'4" and Oklahoma sophomore J. D. Martin's 14'104" - the

best collegiate vaulting in history.

Hazley, second to Tidwell in the 100 by inches, ran on OSU's runner-up 440 relay team, set a record of 20.9 for the curve 220, and anchored a record 3:10.5 mile relay team.

Bill Alley of Kansas hurt his elbow throwing a record 256'10" in the jave-

lin prelims, and withdrew from the finals.

Chuck Carlson of Colorado set a new 440 record with a fine 46.5, leading all the way. In the half, Mike Peake of Colorado led by a yard at the 440, surrendered the lead just before the last turn, hung on, but lost out in the stretch drive to Joe Mullins of Nebraska. Mullins, a Canadian, at last lived up to his promise as a prep, his 1:49.0 being the nation's fastest time this year.

Miler Gail Hodgson set out to run an NC AA pace and blistered through 59.0, 1:58.7 and 2:59.1. He continued on through another 30 second furlong, then went stone-legged and plodded home in 4:06.2, good enough to erase a Wes Santee record. Still another figure fell in the two mile which was a race for over 7½ laps. Defending champ Bernie Frakes, Miles Eisenman and Billy Mills were all even for six laps but by seven, reached in a hot 7:57.7, Frakes was trailing by 10. Oklahoma Stater Eisenman shook Mills going into the last bend and inched away for a 10 yard win in 9:04.8. Mills' 9:06 was the fastest ever by a Big 8 soph.

The relay was a high class thriller. Hazley took the anchor carry with a three yard lead on Deloss Dodds, who had clocked 47.0 for second in the quarter and who is a relay whiz. It took a 46.5 anchor by Hazley to win by less

than six inches.
