MANHATTAN, KAN. — Iowa State had three double winners — including Peg Neppel and Robin Evan's tie in the mile and two-mile runs — to win the Big Eight Women's track championship with 200 points Saturday.

Cathy Newman captured the 100-yard dash and long jump with 11.1-second and 18-foot 7½-inch efforts. Sherry Edwards captured the 220 and 440.

Neppel and Evans clocked the mile in 5:24.9 and turned in a time of 11:57.1 for the two mile.

Kansas State finished second with 129 points with Oklahoma State was third with 62.

Oklahoma State's Marilyn Linfenmeyer was the only other double winner as she took the 440-yard hurdles and won the high jump.
