AMES, IA. — Iowa State's powerful team rolled up 269 points to easily win the Big Eight Conference Women's track meet here Friday.

Peg Neppel, a member of the U.S. national cross-country team, captured the 880, mile and two-mile events to pace the Cyclones.

Debbie Carroll won the 100 and 200-yard dashes for Iowa State while freshman Pat Hodgson took the 440-hurdles, tied for first in the high jump, finished second in the 100-meter hurdles and ran a 58.3-second leg on the winning mile relay team.
