ISU women take third Big 8 title

Team Scoring

Iowa State captured its third consecutive Big Eight Conference women's track championship Saturday at Drake Stadium.

The Cyclones had 226 points to out-distance runner-up Kansas State's 186 total. Kansas was third and Nebraska fourth.

Records were set in 11 of 17 events with Iowa State freshman Debbie Esser of Woodbine setting two of the marks.

Esser broke the 440-yard hurdles mark of 1 minute 3.9 seconds with a clocking of 1:01.59. She also set a record in the 100-meter hurdles and ran on the Cyclones' victorious 440 and mile relay squads.

Peg Neppel of Iowa State, American record holder at 5,000 meters, won the three-mile run and finished second in both the two-mile and mile. Iowa State's only other double-winner was Sherry Edwards in the 220 and 440.

The only other double-winner in the meet was Kansas State's Renee Urish, who upset Neppel and teammate Teri Anderson in a record-breaking mile and also won the 880.
