NU women snare Big 8 track crown

LINCOLN, Neb. (UPI) — Merlene Ottey set a Big Eight record in the 100 meters and anchored Nebraska's record-setting 440-yard relay team Saturday to lead Nebraska to the Big Eight Conference women's outdoor track title.

Nebraska, which also won the 1980 Big Eight indoor championships, finished with 124 points, runner-up Kansas finished with 105 and defending champion Iowa State was third with 97.

Ottey set Big Eight marks in both the 100 and 200 meters during Friday's preliminaries, and bettered her 100-meter time in Saturday's finals by two-tenths of a second. Ottey, Robin Mills, Cindy Tatum and Cheryl Zajic won the 440-yard relay.
