Track Events

Mile—Won by John Munski, Missouri; second, Ray Harris, Kansas; third, Ernest Klann, Kansas; fourth, Llewellyn Hughes, Iowa State. Time, 4:17. (New Big Six indoor record; old record of 4:19.2 set in 1938 by Munski.)

60-yard dash—Won by Edward Toribio, Oklahoma; second, Lloyd Wright, Nebraska; third, Frank Ladd, Kansas State; fourth, Fred Coogan, Oklahoma. Time, :06.4.

440-yard dash—Won by Robert Simmons, Nebraska; second, Richard Toole, Kansas State; third, Ray Gahan, Oklahoma; fourth, Paul Brown, Kansas State. Time, :59.4. (New Big Six indoor record; old record of :51.2 set in 1923 by Deke Wolters of Iowa State.)

Two-mile run—Won by Charles Mitchell, Kansas State; second, Ray Harris, Kansas; third, John Munski, Missouri; fourth, Paul Burrus, Missouri. Time, 9:42.4.

880-yard run—Won by Marshall Reeves, Missouri; second, Roger Bailey, Iowa State; third, Dean Brown, Missouri; fourth, Ray Gahan, Oklahoma. Time, 1:58.4.

60-yard low hurdles—Won by Paul Masoner, Kansas; second, Robert Kahler, Nebraska; third, John White, Missouri; fourth, Robert Simmons, Nebraska. Time, :07.

One-mile relay—Won by Missouri (Ralph Priesmeyer, John Baldwin, Marshall Reeves, Wilbert Berg); second, Oklahoma; third, Iowa State; fourth, Kansas State. Time, 3:29.6.

60-yard high hurdles—Won by Jack Morris, Oklahoma; second, Richard Hotchkiss, Kansas State; third, John White, Missouri; fourth, John Baldwin, Missouri. Time, :07.6. (Ties Big Six indoor record set in 1932 by Harry Hinckley of Kansas State and equalled in this year's preliminaries by White and Hotchkiss.)

Shot put—Won by Elmer Hackney, Kansas State, 50 feet 7½ inches; second, Robert Mills, Nebraska, 49 feet 11 inches; third, Edsel Wibbels, Nebraska, 48 feet 8½ inches; fourth, Chester Friedland, Kansas, 46 feet 1 inch.

Pole vault—Won by Don Bird, Kansas, 13 feet 7¼ inches; second, Warren Sargent, Iowa State, 13 feet 4 inches; third, Albert Tone, Oklahoma, 13 feet; tied for fourth, Harold Scott, Nebraska, Robert Neumann, Nebraska, Malcolm Orr, Oklahoma, and Harry Fender, Oklahoma, 12 feet 6 inches. (New Big Six indoor record; old record of 13 feet 2¼ inches set in 1936 by Joe Lyon of Iowa State.)

High jump—Won by Robert Stoland, Kansas, 6 feet 3¼ inches; second, Richard Schnacke, Iowa State, 6 feet 2 inches; fourth, Frank Hilton, Missouri, 6 feet. (New Big Six indoor record. Old record of 6 feet 3¼ inches set in 1929 by Lya Shelby of Oklahoma.)

Broad jump—Won by Sol Schumitaky, Missouri, 23 feet 6 inches; second, Graham Porter, Missouri, 23 feet 2 inches; tied for third and fourth, John Slayton, Missouri, and Jack Phillips, Iowa State, 22 feet 5½ inches.
