60-yard high hurdles—Won by Edward Darden, Kansas State; second, William Smutz, Nebraska; third, Ralph King, Nebraska; fourth, Robert Hodges, Oklahoma. Time—:07.7. (Smutz fell after clearing last hurdle.)

60-yard dash—Won by Eugene Littler, Nebraska; second, Orville Mathews, Oklahoma; third, Owen Joggerst, Missouri; fourth, Donald Walters, Missouri. Time—:06.3. (Ties record set by Littler in 1940 and equaled by Walters in 1941 and bettered by Walters (06.2) in Saturday's preliminaries.)

60-yard low hurdles—Won by William Smutz, Nebraska; second, Joseph Shy, Missouri; third, John Heggen, Iowa State; fourth, Edward Darden, Kansas State. Time—:07.1.

Mile run—Won by Robert Ginn, Nebraska; second, Albert Rues, Kansas State; third, Marlow Burgy, Iowa State; fourth, Hoyt Burns, Oklahoma. Time—4:21. (New conference board track record, replacing 4:28.4 by John Munski of Missouri in 1940.)

440-yard dash—Won by William Lyda, Oklahoma; second, William Conner, Nebraska; third, James Johns, Kansas State; fourth, James Upham, Kansas State. (Eugene Littler of Nebraska scratched). Time—:49.3. (New conference board track record, replacing :50.1 by Eugene Littler of Nebraska in 1941. Conner of Nebraska, at :49.8 also broke the old record.)

Two-mile run—Won by Richard Smethers, Oklahoma; second, Robert Ginn, Nebraska; third, Donald Borthwick, Kansas State; fourth, Keith French, Missouri. Time—9:52.2.

880-yard run—Won by William Lyda, Oklahoma; second, Arden Kersey, Nebraska; third, Rufus Miller, Kansas State; fourth, Ray Rayl, Missouri. Time—1:57.9.

One-mile relay (first section)—Won by Nebraska (Don Morris, Paul Davidson, William Smutz, William Conner); second, Iowa State (John Phenix, Robert Moats, John Gibson, Robert Winders); third, Kansas (Fred Eberhart, William Brownlee, Richard Edwards, Donald Pollom). Time—3:29.7, 3:34.8, 3:38.

One-mile relay (second section)—Won by Oklahoma (Joe McKinsey, John Sharpe, Son Wright, William Lyda); second, Kansas State (Robert Keith, Max Granfield, James Johns, James Upham); third, Missouri (Donald Walters, O. B. Crawford, Richard Potter, Jack Tracy). Time—3:29.7, 3:30.7, 3:32.5.

One-mile relay, final comparison—Tied for first, Nebraska and Oklahoma; third, Kansas State; fourth, Missouri.

Field Events

Broad jump—Won by Kenneth Farris, Oklahoma, 22 feet 11½ inches; second, John Feiser, Kansas State, 22 feet 9¼ inches; third, Donald Morris, Nebraska, 22 feet 5¾ inches; fourth, Everett Norcross, Iowa State, 22 feet 5½ inches. (New conference board track record, beating distance of 22 feet 10½ inches set in 1940 by J. R. Jones of Kansas.)

Shot put—Won by Elmer Aussieker, Missouri, 49 feet; second, Edsel Wibbels, Nebraska, 48 feet 2¾ inches; third, Victor Schleich, Nebraska, 48 feet 1½ inches; fourth, Plato Andros, Oklahoma, 45 feet 3¾ inches.

High jump—Won by Dale Steffey, Missouri, 5 feet 11¾ inches; tied for second, Paul Meyers, Missouri, and Harry Ruhsam, Iowa State, 5 feet 11 inches; tied for fourth, Donald O'Hara, Missouri and Paul Schroeder, Kansas State, 5 feet 10 inches.

Pole vault—Won by Harold Hunt, Nebraska, 13 feet 10½ inches; tied for second, Howard Debus, Nebraska, and William Rothwell, Missouri, 13 feet 4 inches; tied for fourth, Charles Binning, Iowa State, and Ernest Nelson, Kansas State, 12 feet 6 inches. (New conference board track record, replacing 13 feet 8¼ inches set by Hunt in 1941.)
