Lumberjacks End ISU Reign

Northern Arizona, a Big Sky Conference newcomer, literally snatched victory from the hands of Idaho State Saturday to win the league's 1971 track and field title at Dornblaser Stadium

A scoring error originally gave Idaho State a 74-73 lead over the Lumberiacks and an eighth straight Big Sky crown

Shortly after gleeful team members had dumped ISU Coach Bob Beeten in the steeplechase pond, their crown was snatched away from them when an error was discovered in placing of javelin finalists.

The first correction gave NAU a three-point spread over the Bengals, but when everything was rechecked, the margin was 71-70

"One point's as good as a million." said an elated NAU Coach Leo Haberlack, who was next to take a dip in the pond.

Montana, with some excellent performances, grabbed third place with 60 points, with Boise State fourth at 31. Montana State fifth at 25. Weber State sixth at 19, and Idaho last with

Idaho State freshman sprinter Carl Lawson stole the Saturday night show, zipping to conference and stadium records of 9.3 seconds in the 100-vard dash and 20.6 in the 220. He also put on a tremendous come-from-behind effort to give Idaho State first in the 440-vard relay after Montana was disqualified on its initial exchange

stadium marks were shattered including four each by Lawson and Northern Arizona's machine-gun distance runner Richard Sliney

Sliney, in addition to his steeplechase mark of Friday night. set stadium and conference marks of 13:55.0 in the three mile. He. teammates Dave Tocheri in second and Dan Sauers in fourth, and Montana's Wade Jacobsen in third all broke the old league mark of 14: 21 in the event and the stadium record of 14:25 6

Jacobsen led for the first eight laps of the race, but Sliney overtook him in the ninth lap and Tocheri in the final go-around. It was Jacobsen's best time (14: 13.3) by 10 seconds

Greg Smithey of Idaho state demolished league (15-31/2) and stadium (14-6) pole vault marks by going 16-0 Saturday. He said afterward that his best has been 16-01/2 indoors prior to the Big Sky meet.

Three men also broke the old conference mile mark, and four busted the stadium standard in the same event. NAU's Richard Selby won in 4:10.7, teammate Steve Cross was next in 4:11.0. and Montana State's Jim Robbins took third in 4:11.9. Fourth belonged to Tocheri in 4:12.2.

The old league record of 4: 12.0 by Montana's Doug Brown stood since 1965. Ray Velez of Montana had the stadium mark of 4:13.3

In the 880 more than one man broke the old marks of 1:52.9. First went surprisingly to Idaho's Jim Ferguson in 1:51.9, and In all, seven league and seven Grizzly Dick Miller, a sopho-

more blazed to second in 1:52.5 Third and fourth winners Herb Glassen and Alex Vlaszonek of Boise State also busted the old marks with 1:52 7

Montana Coach Harley Lewis. looking at the outcome, was particularly pleased with the efforts of Miller and Jacobsen, and also had good words for his high hurdle group, which finished first, third and fourth

First went to Barry Mortenson in :14.6 and third to Rick Kendall in :14.8. Both are sophomores. Frosh Jon Williamson got fourth in :14.9.

Montana also got third (Steve Hopkins) and fourth (Bill Codd) in the 440, second (Dick Koontz) and fifth (Larry Keltner) in the intermediate hurdles, fifth (Lee Urbaniak) in the pole vault and second in the mile relay.

Also placing Saturday were Glenn Chaffey (second) and Many Kigame (third) in the triple jump.

Mark Doane, as expected,

took first in the shot put for Montana Keith Kerbel finished third in the 220
