## CALIFORNIA STATE CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP

### COMMENT '70

The course seemed to be in pretty good shape and the rain did not really create too many problems. The dampness created a slower race than had been run in the So. Cal. finals the previous week. Calculating each of the So. Cal. runners times in comparison to the state meet, we show an average of 21 seconds slower per man.

Teamwise, L.A. Valley was evident as the winner early in the race as they kept three men in the top ten all the way. Keith Grinnell and Jeff Clenard made great improvement over their previous weeks performance to make it a runaway for L.A. Valley and give them three wins in a row for the state. The 39 points tied the lowest point total also. One other record they set was a 1:41:54 total team time to break the old record of 1:42:39 set by Santa Ana the previous week. This came despite the 21 seconds slower course. Special congratulations go to Laslo Tabori and George Ken. Santa Ana stayed in there to edge out Mt. SAC as these teams finished within five points of each other the second week in a row. Bakersfields close grouping pattern was still evident although David Gathings moved up from the group to place 16th overall. El Camino had the individual winner in Bruce Johnson and an excellent 2nd man in Stephens at 4th place and a good third man in Goodfriend at 14th overall. They dropped way down in 4th and 5th and had the unusual situation of having the first man and the last man to finish. West Valley improved their No. Cal. finish to defeat all the No. Cal. teams and finish 6th at state.

The team scores were changed somewhat by the discovery that one individual had received a team place card. This affected all teams except L.A. Valley. The handing out of the individual cards was not as efficient as it should have been and the final placing of all runners in the race was done by the use of the videotape of the finish. All times were double checked against the tape also. This use of videotape to check your race results is an extremely effective way to back up a race. I believe we have seen the finish about 20 times since the race.

Individually the field did not let Babiracki of Valley get away early as he had the week before and Bruce Johnson, after having been outsprinted in the last 180 yds. the previous week, smartly took the lead and built it up over the last half mile to finish as the 1970 California State J.C. Champion. Lloyd Apgar of San Diego stayed up closer this week and ran a close third. Ray Stephens stayed further back this week but closed very fast in the last half mile to finish 4th. Jack Bush of San Jose made an excellent showing individually and was the only No. Cal. runner in the top 15 as he finished 7th overall.

The next use of the Moorpark course will be Saturday, September 26th, 1971 at the Moorpark College Invitational and it will be very interesting to compare the times in that meet to this years times. This years races were won by McKeon of Golden West in 21:13 and Lipski of Santa Ana in 21:18. You are all invited to this early season race to make your own comparison.
