## GENERAL COMMENTS

A new system of scoring using numbers for placement rather than giving tongue depressors was attempted. Its purpose was to eliminate the jam up and difficulties in getting the tongue depressors to the right man. It is felt that the system has merit but may need to be eliminated unless all teams comply.

Some teams arrived late and did not place numbers on their jerseys. This would slow down scoring. Late arrival also prevented team members from walking the course in order to become familiar with the general configuration. It further is suggested that all future meets be established at 3 P. M. to avoid confusion.

The host school could easily lose money since the entry fees are to pay for trophies. For future meets, it is suggested that the first 3 teams of each conference be required to send in their entrance fees of \$1.00 per man as it is in track. This would assure the host school of enough funds to cover medals & trophies.

The entry fees will cover the expenses for this meet, although some fees have not yet been paid.
