

Dick Krenzer Wins Crown In Long Run

Dick Krenzer of Valley College won the individual championship in the Southern California Junior College Cross-Country Championships at Pierce College, but the Monarchs finished third in the team standings behind champion Santa Ana and runner-up Pierce.

The Brahmas were surprisingly high placers in the race, which drew an entry list of 146 runners from 22 different Southland junior colleges.

Santa Ana finished with 72 points, 14 more than Pierce. Valley was just three behind Pierce with 89.

Others in the top 10 included Cerritos with 118, Glendale with 130, El Camino with 175, Fullerton with 192, Long Beach with 223, San Diego with 256 and Orange Coast with 259.

Other scores:

San Bernardino Valley 273, Trade Tech 339, Citrus 369, Mt. SAC 373, Bakersfield 400, Compton 413, Los Angeles City College 501, Santa Monica 517, East Los Angeles 523 and Harbor 550.

Four Valley and Pierce runners were among the top 10 finishers.

Behind Krenzer were Dick Weeks of Pierce in third place, Martin Cooley of Pierce in sixth place and Joe Jacobsen of Valley in eighth place.

Krenzer ran the 3.2 mile course in 16:51, beating San Diego's Sterling Jenkins by five full seconds.

Weeks was clocked in 17:07, Cooley in 17:21 and Jacobsen in 17:30.
