

Wheaton college, as expected, won its fourth straight Little Nine conference track and field championship here today with 77 4-5 points as eight records went into the books.

The Crusaders' only opposition came from Millikin, which finished second with 56½ points—far ahead of third place Wesleyan with 24½ points.

Next in line was Augustana with 22½, North Central 21, Carthage 17 7-10, Illinois College 3 and Carthage 2 2-5. Lake Forest did not enter a team.
