Johnny Luttrell, Millikin's ace distance runner, prevented the sixth annual Little Nine track and field championships from being an all-Wheaton show here today at Lake Forest high school athletic field by setting two new conference records. While Wheaton piled up 8734 points and its individual star, Sonny Price, won four events, Luttrell crowded into the spotlight by breaking his own mile record and setting a new standard in the two mile. Paced by Luttrell, the Millikin team grabbed off second place with 1834 points followed by Elmhurst with 3034; Augustana 29, North Central 1414; Illinois Wesleyan 8, Carthage 7.
