

Carroll College, only Wisconsin school in the College Conference of Illinois, won its first CCI track championship Saturday, edging out five other conference schools in the closest meet in the league's 14-year history.

The Pioneers amassed 46 points to 44½ for second-place Lake Forest and 40 2-5 for host Augustana to win the 1960 title in the meet held at Ericson Field.

Emhurst finished fourth with 33 points, North Central had 28 1-5 for fifth and Millikin picked up 27 7-10 for sixth. Illinois Wesleyan was a distant last with 4 1-5 points.

With Wheaton, champion of the CCI meet for 12 out of 13 years, no longer in the league, the meet was turned into a well-balanced affair that saw five schools get in on first place honors and four records broken.

With all Wheaton records no longer standing on the books, the records used for the meet were those set through the years by the

other seven CCI schools.

Craig, who also broke the 220 yard low hurdle standard, has a :09.9 timing in the 100 Friday, cutting one-tenth of a second off the previous record. Saturday on the wet track, he ran the 100 in :10.0. Craig's time of :25.3 set a record in the low hurdle event. Best time previously was :26.1 for the race when run on a curve.

Other record-breaker was Elmhurst's Boyd Bender. Bender won the 220 yard dash in :21.9, bettering the mark of :22.6 set in 1947.
