

Augie breaks North Central grip on CCIW track crown

With all-around performer Socrates Catavatis and sprinter Mike Meyer leading the way, Augustana broke a five-year North Central stranglehold on the CCIW track and field championship this weekend, outpointing the 237½ to 171 in the two-day meet held Friday and Saturday at Ericson Stadium.

Catavatis nipped Meyer for the outstanding performer award, based on the number of points scored.

He won the decathlon and the long jump, and finished third in the triple jump for 26 points. Meyer was credited with 25 points, winning both the 100 and 200 meter dashes.

IT WAS A two-team race, with North Central holding a slim 42-39 edge at the completion of Friday's events. Wheaton finished a distant third with 74 points.

Augie had 15 performers in Saturday's finals, and Catavatis came on to win the decathlon.

Five records were established in the meet, including Catavatis' winning total of 6,614 points in the decathlon, a new event this year.

Augie's Rob Jensen ran the 3,000 meter steeplechase in 9:18, slicing more than 18 seconds of the 1978 standard of 9:36.5 by Bruce Fisher of North Central.

Tom Kerwin of North Central hit an even 7 feet in the high jump, beating the 6-10 mark established in '78 by Augie's Greg Haynie;

Ken Koehler of Carthage trimmed a tenth of a second off the 400 meter record first set in 1973 by former Viking Enyo DeWith, and Ted Carlson of Wheaton bounded over the 400 meter intermediate hurdles in a :51.8 clocking, beating his own 1978 record of :53.1.

OTHER FIRST places for Augie were registered by Dave Lingner in the discus throw, Mel Blaser in the javelin throw on Friday, Mark Nordstrom in the 800 and Brett Anderson in the pole vault.

Augie was particularly strong in the shorter dis-

tances, finishing 1-2-3 in the 100 and 1-3 in the 200.

Kofi Osei was second in the century and third in the 200, and ran on the 400 meter relay team with Terry McMillan, Tom Sparkman and Meyer. The mile relay unit was Kurt Redenbo, Mike Barber, Sparkman and Meyer.

Sparkman was second in the open 400, freshman Lonnie Hewitt was second with a 6-10 high jump, Dan Papineau was runnerup in the 800 meters and John Isbell second in the 1,500.
