

PURPLE TEAM SURPRISES.

Local High School Teams Win First Four Places in Sensational Meet.

Los Angeles high schools took the first four places in the annual Southern California interscholastic track and field meet at Los Angeles High yesterday. Manual Arts won by many lengths. Los Angeles High was second, Lincoln third and Harvard fourth. The Southern California high school record for the discus throw was broken by "Husky" Guffman of Harvard, who hurled the disc 117 feet 7 3/4 inches. The former record of 115 feet 11 1/4 inches was held by Boyle of Los Angeles High. Records in both hurdles were tied by Dagges, the Claremont hurdler.

Manual clinched the meet by taking the relay after a close finish with Redlands. Harvard taking third, and Los Angeles fourth. Manual Arts is now the only school which has won the handsome relay cup twice, the other winning schools being Long Beach, Redlands, Pasadena, and Pomona.

Wright of Lincoln, who took first in both the 100 and 220 and Dagges, the winner of both hurdles, were tied for individual honors.
