

SPRINT MARKS SHATTERED

Wykoff and Slocum Run 100 in 9.8s. as Glendale Takes Lead in C.I.F.S.S. Trackfest Trials

There is no longer any maybe about the sprinting ability of Frank Wykoff and Russ Slocum, the dynamic Dynamiters from the Glendale High School. Jabbing their spikes in the Coliseum cinderpath yesterday afternoon in competition with the fastest field of dash men ever assembled in a Southern California C.I.F. trial trackfest, the Glendale sprinters shattered the century mark of 10s. flat which has stood since 1918 when Sir Charles Paddock galloped for Pasadena High. The new record, made under the strictest timing rules, is 9 4-5s.

After yesterday's dazzling performances, with Glendale standing head and shoulders above a brilliant collection of athletes, the Dynamiters are a good bet at any odds to win the Southern California championship next Saturday. Glendale has a possible 37 points in the finals, and there isn't another prep school in the Southland that can come within a mile of that total.
