ZAMPERINI VS. BRIGHT

Rivaling the Meadows-Sefton duel in the pole vault, will be the featured 1500-meter run, in which Louie Zamperini and Norman Bright, the West's two greatest distance runners, will meet in a rematch race. The battle between this pair of stars last year in the 1500 meter was the standout race of the meet. Bright nipped Zamperini by a margin of less than six inches.

Zamperini has been training intensively for his rematch race with the San Francisco Olympian and is now in the best shape of his career. The Torrance star is confident that he can run close to the American record of 3m. 48.8s.

Zamperini surprised the nation's collegiate aces last year, when he finished in virtually a dead heat with Don Lash for a place on the American Olympic team. At Berlin, Zamperini ran away from his American mates and finished seventh in the international games, several yards ahead of Lash.

Bright is equally confident that he will win at Compton. He has been running better this year than at any time in his career. In the indoor meets in the East,
