Eddie Morris, the nation's ace prep sprinter from Huntington Beach High, was the lone double victor, but his marks weren't up to expectations. The husky junior nabbed the 100 in 10s. flat and snared the 220 in the more satisfactory time of 21.6s. Jim Jenkins of Compton was second both times.

Little bronze-skinned Al Heredia, San Diego's undefeated miler, toured the four laps in the blistering time of 4m. 29.3s., but he had to give his all to beat out Herman Stanfill of Montebello, who dogged his footsteps the entire distance and almost passed him a couple of times in the stretch. Heredia won by about two yards.

ANTUNEZ TRIUMPHS

Army Antunez of Glendale defeated a fast field in the 440, breasting the tape in 49.6s. Marcus Shaw, Monrovia Negro, took the 120 high hurdles in 15.5s., and Herb McCoy, blond Pasadena J.C. frosh ace, won the 220 lows in 25s.

Three pole vaulters—Frank Ferguson of Inglewood, Bud Humberger of Glendale and Jim Stanglen of Huntington Beach—all tied for first in the bamboo event at 12ft. 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ in., and then Humberger went on to negotiate an unofficial height of 13ft. 3in. Frank Minini, Paso Robles, heaved the shot 52ft. 11in.; Bob Sprinkle of Claremont high-jumped 6ft. 3in.; Bill Bardon of Compton broad-jumped 22ft. 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ in., and Tom Herrin of Point Loma did the hop, step and jump at 44ft. 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ in.
