

# Hoover High of Glendale Wins Oxnard Meet

## Compton Garner Second Honors in C.I.F. Competition

OXNARD, Cal. (AP) — Herbert Hoover High school of Glendale nosed out defending state champion Redondo Beach, 24½ to 24, in the southern section, California Interscholastic federation track and field meet yesterday.

Compton High was next with 22 5/6 and Woodrow Wilson of Long Beach fourth with 16.

Redondo's favored hurdler Ronnie Dixon, was bumped on the first barrier and failed to collect a point. Glendale's John Bradley won the 100 yard dash in 9.7 seconds and the 220 in 21.7 to lead his team to the win.

### RECORDS NOT ALLOWED

Several meet records were bettered but were not allowed because of a 10-mile tail wind.

Beverly Hills won the B-class meet with 17 points, trailed by Mark Keppel of Alhambra, 14, and Jordan of Long Beach, 10.

Santa Barbara and Alhambra tied for first in the C-class with 12 points apiece, and Ventura Junior high was third with 9.
