Howard Bugbee of Redondo, who got away to a flashy start, blazed to a 9.6s. century victory with Compton's Bill Fell only a yard back. Bradley, after a miserable start, moved up to barely salvage third spot. The time tied the CIF, Southern Section, record set by Eddie Morris of Huntington Beach in 1940.

Bradley came back to edge Fell in a spectacular 220 in 21s. by less than a foot with Bugbee a fading third, three yards back. The first two, running in alternate lanes, raced neck and neck all the way.

### Good Marks

Other creditable marks were scored by Compton's Jerome Walters, who took the mile by 20 yards in 4m. 26.9s.; a 13ft. pole vault by Bob Barnes of Fullerton; Verle Sorgen, Riverside, broad-jumped 23ft. 2½ in., and Bob Van Doren, San Diego, pushed the shot 55ft. ¼ in.

Long Beach Poly nipped Glendale for Class B laurels, 21-20½, and Redondo took first in Class C competition with 16 points to San Bernardino's 15.
