

event almost provided an all-time shocker. Ronnie Morris of Burroughs, who has an application in for a national prep mark of 13ft. 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ in., was not up to par and only tied for third with McDowell and Bob Voiles of El Monte. Gates Foss of Santa Barbara won at 13ft. 4in. and Burbank's Carl Mersola was second at 12ft. 10in.

Since Morris and Voiles were tied in least number of misses to decide the third man that qualifies for the State meet, they had a jumpoff. Morris flew over 12ft. 8in. by about a foot, but then so did Voiles. At 13ft. 2in. Morris again sailed over easily while Voiles barely missed, giving Morris the spot.

Compton, the favorite off its nine shots at points, fell below expectations in the 440 and wound up third at 14. It was a meet in which the slightest slip meant everything.

14.4 and 19.1

Naturally, the hurdle clockings were also fast. Harry Healey of Keppel took the highs by two feet in 14.4 while Lin Sitton, runner-up in the tall stick race, rambled over the lows in 19.1 for an easy win.

The 440 and 880 races proved thrillers, as expected. Bruce Kitchen of Riverside won a 5-man blanket finish in the one-lapper around two turns in 50.9. Blonde Ray Coyle of Bonita held on to take the half mile in 2:00.8.

The latter race involved six lads with better than two minute marks but the wind ruined any chance of fast time. Compton's Ford Sims set the pace on the first lap, 56 seconds, but couldn't hold it. Teammate Russ Ellis, Ty Hadley of Bellflower and Bob Schumaker of Huntington Beach all made runs at the pace setting on the backstretch of the last lap but it was Coyle who had the kick in the final dash against the wind. Ellis was second a foot back and Hadley third, two feet away.
