a too-fast first half proved his undoing. He won easily in 4:22.1, seven-tenths better than his previous best. Neal set all the pace, 60.5 for the 440 and 2:06 at the half. He was still ahead of schedule at the 1320, 3:13.5, but he just didn't have it on the last lap, although the rest of the field couldn't close on him. Bob Monzingo of S.D. Hoover was second at 4:27.2 and John Holland of St. Monica was a fast-closing third at 4:28.

A phenomenal performance in the Class B 1320 saw Tom Lile of Antelope Valley run 3:10.2, smashing the year-old record of 3:11.9. Lile, who ran his last lap in 61, is only a NINTH GRADER!
