

Santa Ana, led as expected by sprint star Jackie White, captured the CIF track and field championship Thursday night at Cerritos College.

A crowd of 11,101 saw White anchor the Saints' relay team to a victory in the 440 event in 41.6, take second in the 100 in 9.7 and then win the 220 convincingly in 21.7.

Santa Ana finished with 24 points while Blair was second with 22. Morning-side, co-favored in the pre-meet analysis with Santa Ana, faltered badly and ended up with 17.

It was the first title for Santa Ana, coached by Earl Engman, since 1954, when the Saints shared the crown with Centennial. The two-mile did not produce a record but a stirring race with Jim Chaffin of LB Poly again out-dueling Dave White of El Modena to win. Both men were timed in 9:01.0.

Chaffin and White ran together for most of the race and then were head-to-head for the final 220 yards with Chaffin, still strong at the finish, able to stay in front as they came down to the wire. Both men ran the final lap in 60.1.

James McAlister of Blair was the only double winner, taking the long jump at 24.7 and the 180 low hurdles in 18.2.

Morningside came back in the night's final event to set the only Varsity record when Al Hall, Percell Keeling, Carl Shaw and Bill Hicks took the mile relay in 3:16.4, breaking the record of 3:16.6 set by Centennial in 1954.

Morningside's chances for the team title disintegrated in the 440 and 880 when Hicks and Keeling failed to win.
