Muir, San Bernardino Win CIF Titles

Muir won the 4-A team title in impressive fashion and two-miler Armando Cendeias pulled the biggest surprise Friday night in the CIF 4-A and 3-A track and field cheampionships at Cerritos College

Muir getting 1-2 finishes by Jim Austin and Fred Shaw in the hurdles an upset win by Bill Smith in the long jump and a victory in the mile relay, finished with 37 points to outdistance Long Beach Poly, which had 27.

In the 3-A division favored San Bernardino easilv took team honors as hurdler Trennis Jackson and sprinter Walter Woodard led the way.

The 4-A team title was the first for Muir since 1966 and the fifth overall for Mustang coach Walter Opp. Muir's total is the third highest in history. topped only by Manual Arts in 1916 (5214) and

Centennial in 1955 (44). Cendeias, a senior from Buena Park who had a best of 9:16.4 this season. jumped the field with about 115 laps to go and held off the challenge of Marina's Gary Blume and Loara's Ralph Sernan to

Shaw and Austin split in the hurdles with both far outdistancing the rest of the field. Shaw took the highs in 13.9 and Austin repeated as low hurdle champion in 18.9.
