# Notre Dame Scores 3-A Track Victory

Notre Dame, paced by a 2-3-4 finish in the 880 and a strong performance by junior sprinter Marc Jenkins, easily won the CIF 3-A track and field championship Saturday at El Modena High School with 56 points.

Larry Hayden of Sunny Hills won the 880 in 1:54.2 but Steve McKenna, Bruce Rocheleau and Brian Russell took the next three places and Notre Dame was never threatened the rest of the way.

Jenkins ran back to his early-season times, finishing second in both the 100 (9.7w) and the 220 (21.6w) to give the Knights 16 points.

Class 3-A records were set by junior John Elando of South Torrance in the pole vault (15-1), Brad Slinkard of St. Paul in the shot put (62-4<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) and junior Kelly Johnson of Arroyo in the high jump (6-8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>).

Elando, whose previous best mark was 13-6, broke his pole while vaulting and was forced to switch to a heavier test pole. As a result, he improved his previous best by 19 inches.

Junior Norris Jones won the 100 and 220 with wind-aided times of 9.7 and 21.3 and anchored the winning 440 relay team as Kennedy of Barstow finished second in the team race with 31 points.

# Mission Viejo Wins 2-A Track Title

Mission Viejo, scoring in eight of the 14 events, totaled 51 points to outscore Duarte by 10 points and win the CIF Class 2-A track and field championship Saturday night at Valencia High.

The Diablos' only first place came in the 120 high hurdles when Wilbur Gregory ran a wind-aided 14.1.

Eric Hulst of Laguna Beach won the two mile for the third straight year and the mile for the second straight time. Hulst set a meet record of 8:57.0 in the two mile and clocked 4:13.9 in the mile to miss his own mark by two tenths of a second.

Outstanding performances were recorded in the field events as Brian Goodman of Agoura became the fourth Southern Section vaulter to clear 16 feet this year when he won at 16-0¼ and sophomore Jeff Lawson of El Dorado equaled the meet record in the high jump with a 6-8 effort.

Freshman Ken Lawler of Verbum Dei won the 100 and anchored the winning 440 relay team as the Eagles took the frosh-soph division.
