■ Redlands sprinter wins CIF titles in 100, 200 — first large schools county athlete to double in 82 years. Five other county athletes are double qualifiers for Masters meet.

LONG BEACH — Redlands sprinter Pat Johnson didn't set any speed records Saturday at the CIF Track and Field Finals, but he certainly made history as far as San Bernardino County competitors go.

Johnson won the 100- and 200-meter dashes in the Division I Finals to become the first county athlete to accomplish the feat in 82 years in the large schools division.

Johnson was one of 16 boys and girls event qualifiers from the county for the CIF Masters Meet to be held Friday at Cerritos College. The top nine times or distances in each of the four divisions advanced to Masters.

Johnson was a double qualifier for the Masters, while Eisenhower's Demond Birks and Arthur Lloyd, Chino's Jesus Reyes and Thomas Schmidt and Etiwanda's Jaime Sims matched the feat.

With a head wind slowing his times at Veterans Memorial Stadium, Johnson still ran a respectable 10.61 in the 100 and 21.25 in the 200 to win easily in both.

"I was really anxious to get the races over with," Johnson said.

His anxiety hit Friday night. He said he didn't fall asleep until 1:30 a.m. because of nervousness and suffered a headache all Saturday. "I'm paranoid." Johnson said.

"I still keep thinking I'm not supposed to be doing this."

Johnson's times were second

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only to Canyon Springs' Bryan Howard, who ran a 10.50 in the 100 and a Division II-record 20.76 in the 200.

With surprisingly quick starts, Johnson got out to comfortable leads in his races and let up considerably before the finishes.

"I have no doubt that records are going to fall next week at Masters." Johnson said. "If it isn't

me, then it will be Bryan."

Johnson became the first county sprinter to double in the 100 and 200 since Robet Bivens did it in Division 3A in 1989.

He also became the first Redlands sprinter in history to win a CIF 100 title

In addition, with his back-toback CIF titles in the 200, he becomes the first county athlete to accomplish that since Jim Ortig of Barstow won the 3,200 in 1982-83.

To top off his day, Johnson anchored Redlands' 1,600 relay team of Andrew Braham, Keith Morse and Louis Young to what appeared to be a second-place finish in a time of 3:18.8.

But judges ruled after the race that the Terriers' lead runner, Braham, stepped on an inside line around the final turn and disqualified the team. Alta Loma, which finished third and would also have qualified for the Masters with Redlands, was called for the same infraction.

Other top county performers Saturday:

■ Birks, who finished second to Johnson in the 100 (10.81) and 200 (21.58). His times were the

Carson, Institutes were the fourth-fastest in all divisions.

"Last year at this time I was sitting at home," said Birks, a senior. He missed the team bus last year and missed out on qualify-

ing. "So I'm real happy to make up for that."
■ Lloyd won the Division I long jump (23-1½) as the second-best Masters qualifier. But he had to wait around six hours to start the high jump, which began 10

minutes after the final running event was over. "I was so stiff and tired by the time it started," said Lloyd. "This

was the longest day of my life."
He still took second at 7-0—
the fourth time he's cleared 7-0 or
better this season— and was the
second-best qualifier.

■ Chino's Reyes qualified in the 100 (10.83) and long jump (23-1½) while teammate Schmidt advanced in the discus (162-7) and shot put (57-7½).

■ Sims qualified in the 100 (12.18) and with Jaime Taylor, Erika Bowlings and Katrina Brooks in the 400 relay (47.38).
