. MODESTO, April 28 .- The Modesto junior college with 441/2 points today won the first annual track and field meet of the California coast conference of secondary colleges held here. Fresno state teachers' college, with 43 points, was second; San Jose state teachers' college, with 32½ points, third; and the Sacramento junior col-lege, with 29 points, fourth.

Ragon Stars Ragan of Modesta was the indi-

vidual star of the day, winning first in both the 220 yard low and the 120 yard high hurdles and tying with Acres of San Jose for second in the high jump. Ragan was given a stiff race in both hurdle events by Wells of the Fresno state teachers' college. Wells was doped to win both events. Storle, crack distance runner of the

San Jose state teachers' college, ran the 220 yard dash in 22 flat, and stepped the 440 yard dash in 51 4-5. Smith of Sacramento placed second in the 440 event.

Monferino, miler of San Jose, upset the dope by defeating Smith of Sac-ramento. The prune city lad turned the distance in 4:54 against a stiff breeze. He was 25 yards ahead of Smith at the finish.

Smith of Sacramento ran true to form in the 880 yard dash and won this event in 2:5 2-5. Gerken, Modesto weightman, threw the 16 pound shot 44 feet, 7 inches, and heaved the

discus 117 feet, 6 inches.
