

# Taft Finishes Second in Meet; Porterville Gets Third

**W**HIPPED on by a chilling temperature, athletes of the Central California Junior College Conference set new records in 13 out of 15 events in their annual track and field meet here last night. The only marks to withstand assaults by the 1932 crop of Jaysees were the time of 21.6 seconds in the 220, set by Jim Tyack of Bakersfield last year, and high jump mark set by Eiland of Taft.

In a meet characterized by brilliant performances under the floodlights, there were some that still stood out above all others.

### Livingston Stars

There was Livingston, Taft's distance man, who romped away with the mile in the excellent time of 4:45.8, then running again in the gruelling two-mile event, finished his twelfth lap around Griffith Field for the evening at a sprint. He very nearly lapped other contestants in his second race.

Sickles of Porterville came up to advance notice by taking both 440 and 880, in two of the prettiest races of the evening. Running the last lap for Porterville in the relay, Sickles stood off a valiant effort by Tyack of Bakersfield to cut down a lead of several yards held by the Porterville man. Sickles' strong finish in the relay gave this event to Porterville and placed his team within half a point of Taft, which finished second in the meet.

Bill van Osdel, Bakersfield pole vaulter, cleared 11 feet 4 inches easily to set a record which is expected to stand in the valley Jaysee ledger for some time.

### Tyack Makes 15

Jim Tyack came through with his usual 15 points, taking first in the 100, 220 and broad jump for individual honors.

Bakersfield's biggest haul came in the discus, where Roe, Chatfield and O'Connor placed first, second and third, respectively.
