There was Livingston, Taft's dis-tance man, who romped away with the mile in the excellent time of 4:45.8. then running again in the gruelling two-mile event, finished his twelfth lap around Griffith Field for the evening at a sprint. He very nearly lapped other contestants in his second race.

Sickles of Porterville came up to advance notice by taking both 440 and 880, in two of the prettiest races of the evening. Running the last lap for Porterville in the relay, Sickles stood off a valiant effort by Tyack of Bakersfield to cut down a lead of several yards held by the Porterville man. Sickles' strong finish in the relay gave this event to Porterville and placed his team within half a point of Taft,

which finished second in the meet. Bill van Osdel, Bakersfield pole vaulter, cleared 11 feet 4 inches easily to set a record which is expected to stand in the valley Jaysee ledger for some time.

Jim Tyack came through with his usual 15 points, taking first in the 100, 220 and broad jump for individual honors.
