

RENEGADES VICTORS IN VALLEY MEETING FOR JAYSEE SQUADS

TWO new conference records were set at Taft Saturday evening when Bakersfield Junior College athletes, under the direction of Coach P. M. Bliss, nosed out Taft J. C. for first place in the annual Central California Junior College Conference track and field meet. Jerry McCall, Bakersfield's star middle distance runner, won the half-mile in 2:03.3 to better the old record of 2:05.0, held by Sickles of Porterville, and Richardson of Visalia shattered the low hurdle mark set by Benton of Bakersfield last spring when he won this event in 26 seconds flat.

Bakersfield's total score for the meet was 47½, as against 41 1-6 for Taft in second place. Visalia came third with 39 5-6, Porterville fourth with 27½, and Reedley, 7 points.
