

Delta's Chewing Takes 100, 220

Phil Chewing of San Joaquin Delta College rocketed to victories in the 100 and 220 sprints, and then helped the Mustangs to a 440 relay win to top qualifiers in the wind-hampered Valley Conference Track and Field Championships yesterday at Hughes stadium.

The trackfest, which serves as qualifying for the Nor-Cal JC track competition next week, saw gusty wind prohibit athletes from cracking any number of meet standards.

Dave Garcia, another Delta speedster, collected the only new mark with a 14:22.5 clocking in the three-mile run, almost 20 seconds faster than the old record.

American River College, without the services of weightman Ken Kirschenman who was injured prior to the meet, still managed to grab its share of medals.

Jack Van Kirk led a three-man ARC finish in the pole vault by jumping 14-6,

and Bob McGee ran first in the 440 intermediate hurdles. McGee also added a second in the 120 high hurdles.

Karl Schaechterle, John Weed and Greg Griffin completed a blanket Beaver finish in the three mile to strenghten ARC's claim to distance domination in the league.

Sacramento City College came away with two unexpected winning efforts in the mile relay and shot put. Ray Daniel heaved the iron ball to a lifetime best of 50-4½ to take the honors in the weight event.

Then, in the final event of the day, Leroy Lindsay — who earlier grabbed a fourth in the 440 hurdles — anchored the SCC mile relay squad to a come-from-behind, one-yard victory. John Gilbert, Corbin Scott and Tony Santos also ran on the team.

ARC qualified 19 men for the Nor-Cal meet, while SCC had eight and Cosumnes River College, three.
